##### **CULTURE AND INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM**

**Staff Development EL-Deb Goslin**, our EL teacher, explained her program to all of the teachers and told everyone about the services she will be providing to our EL students on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

**Preschool**-This began on August 27 with an enrollment of 60 students. **David Sowell**s attended the August meeting along with other preschool directors to learn about our state funding.

**Student Council**-We will have elections and officers will be chosen on **September 14**. **We have 3 students running for president, 2 for vice-president, and 1 for secretary.** Thank you to **Cheryl Garlough-Jones, and Eileen O'Brien**, for being the advisors.

These students will be actually participating in a trial at the County Courthouse on October 27, and on that day they will be competing against area schools.

**Middle School Parent Back to School Night** -There was Middle School Parent Meeting on September 6, from 6:00 pm-7:30 pm. Grade information, expectations, curriculum, and athletic eligibility were provided by the teachers. There was also some time for questions and answers. There were 8 different 10 minute sessions and during those times parents could follow their child's schedule so they were able to meet and hear from each teacher.

**Middle School Interventionist** –Our Middle School Math Interventionist, **Pauline Thomsen**, meets with 3-4 Middle School Students each day **and** tutors these Students in Math. She works

very closely with our Math teacher, **Isaac Silver**. She is also a mentor to our new teacher **Maddie Seutter**.

**Tutoring for Middle School Students**-All of our Middle School Teachers, **Pauline Thomsen, Cheryl Jones, Sandy Thomson, Isaac Silver, Ashley Bennett, Adam Tucker,** and **Maddie Seuter** tutor any Middle School Students that would like extra help with their assignments every morning at 7:15 am or after school until 3:00 pm.

**Title I-** All Saints Title I Program serves 117 students K-8 in reading and or Math. **Jill Hixson, Donna Vinar,** and **Mary Morrison,** are the teachers in this program which is held 4 days of week from 3:00pm-4:00 pm. Kara Hamann, a Title I Teacher from Davenport Public Schools, Sue Ryder, a Title I Para also from Davenport Public Schools, also provide services to our Title I students.
