Fruits of the Holy Spirit- The students worked on **Patience** for the month of November. In December everyone will be working on **Peace**. At the October assembly we had a student define **Joy**, share a scripture about **Joy** and gave the students examples of how to show joy here at school or at home. **Sara Hawkins** had the band play the school song. Students are nominated by the teachers each month who are displaying this gift of the Holy Spirit. The students recognized received an out of uniform day and they also had an ice cream treat.

Holy Family Service Project-The All Saints 8th grade members helped the Holy Family Bazaar Committee carry over many items from the Church Basement so the Committee could prepare for their bazaar which was held on November 3. Some of the proceeds from the bazaar go to All Saints Catholic School.

All Saints Catholic School Mass- We had an **All Saints 4:00 all school Mass on November 17, at Sacred Heart Cathedral.**

Father Sia Visit -8th Graders-Father Sia, the Davenport Diocese Vocations Director, met with the All Saints 8th graders and talked to them about vocations. Father Sia explained the various vocations that everyone has in life but especially focusing on the priesthood for the boys and for the girls he talked about being a Sister. He did a video chat with two seminarians who are at Conception Seminary in Conception, Missouri. The two Seminarians did an excellent job talking about their life and how they received the call to be a priest. The students were able to ask questions to the seminarians and Father Sia. He plans on visiting with the other Middle School students soon.

VISION

F.A.S.T –The K-6 All Saints Students continue to be assessed in their literacy skills. Students will take the test 3 times throughout the year. This screener provides teachers and parents with data indicating a student’s competency in the area of reading foundational skills. Students not meeting the benchmark from the reporting period will be scheduled for intervention for up to 3 days per week. All students are progressed monitored weekly so teachers can determine next steps for intervention or completion of intervention.
